4	Once the training is completed, officials from the Department of Occupational Standards will conduct the national assessment together with trained assessors from the Tourism Council of Bhutan and Guide Association of Bhutan. And NC II certificates will be issued to those who score more than 60% in the national assessment. National Competency Standard Certificate (NC II) certificates will be issued to those who score more than 60% in the national assessment.

	A guide license will be issued to those who score more than 60% in national assessment. The successful candidates will report to TCB to process for guide license with the following documents:
